

HOW TO USE this planner

Moving is stressful - but it doesn't have to be! Here's how to use this Moving Planner for the most organized move EVER.

The pages of this planner are designed to be printed on 8.5×11 paper and cut to $7'' \times 9.25''$ for your Happy planner.

These pages are designed with a margin so you can punch holes in the pages and use them in your Happy Planner (or, any 7"x9.25" planning system).

You can print these pages back to front, or you can print one-sided if that's easier for you and your printer. I've included a blank lined sheet of paper that you can easily print on the backside of these pages so you won't have any wasted space.

You might want to print out several sheets of the pages you'll use the most (for example, if you're house hunting you might want a bunch of the House Hunting Notes pages!).

if you take this file to a professional printer, be sure to take the Terms of Service to show the printer. Sometimes, print services won't print files unless they see the copyright agreement. You have the rights to print this file for personal use.

HOW TO USE this planner here's what's included:

- Monthly Calendar Page: Use this page to keep track of important dates and appointments.
- Moving Countdown Timeline: As you get close to moving day, keep track of what needs to be done.
- To-Do List: Use this page to keep your to-dos in one place.
- New Home Checklist: Use this page to keep track of what you need to do for your new home.
- Moving Out Checklist Use this page to keep track of loose ends and other things you need to close out before leaving your current home.
- House Hunting Notes: Looking at houses is overwhelming! Keep track of the homes you visit with this page. Print one for every house you look at.
- Important Contacts: It can be tricky keeping up with all the people involved in moving. Use this form to have them all in one place.
- New Home Wishlist: Use this helpful sheet to decide what you must have in your new home, and what you'd like to have. Give a give a copy to your realtor, too.
- New Home Mood Board: Use this page to collect ideas and inspiration for your new home. You can print one out for every room, or keep everything on one sheet.
- Room Layout: Figuring out where to put the furtniture in a new house is a daunting task. It's really helpful to do this BEFORE you move. Use these pages to plan the layout of each room.
- New Home Expenses: Use this sheet to create a budget for your new home.
- Moving Out Expenses: Use this sheet to plan for and track expenses related to your old home.
